Getting Started

Programs like yours have used Go NAPSACC to implement supportive breastfeeding practices such as establishment of a space for onsite breastfeeding and development of a supportive breastfeeding policy.

Enrolled programs will work with a TA consultant to complete the 5 Steps to Success (listed to the right) and will receive breastfeeding books, toys, and materials for your program. You may also be eligible for a stipend to support creation of an onsite space for breastfeeding or pumping. Finally, you and your TA consultant will complete and submit a Breastfeeding Friendly Child Care Recognition application.

One recognized as CT Breastfeeding Friendly Child Care Provider, you will get both the Breastfeeding Friendly Child Care and the Breastfeeding Friendly Employer awards along with a thank you gift from CT Department of Public Health and CT Breastfeeding Coalition.
